

Stop Work Policy

Excellence Logging acknowledges that our employees and other people involved in our activities have a right to a safe and healthy working environment, besides being firmly committed to maintaining a strong culture of risk awareness.

Our Goals are: optimal prevention of injury to people as well as damages to our property and the environment; health, safety and environmental considerations remain top priorities; foster responsible behaviour.

Company Management holds the responsibility to ensure the requirements of this policy are communicated, understood and applied. All employees, contractors, suppliers, consultants, temporary staff and all personnel affiliated with third parties working for Excellence Logging must apply this policy in good faith and reasonably.

Our requirements are: for everyone to STOP work, check and ask when an unsafe work condition, activity or practice is detected which puts employees, the others or the environment in an imminent danger ; immediately report to responsible manager for further prompt actions; resume work only after all needed corrective actions have been reviewed, agreed, approved and remaining risks – if any, are acceptable.

The individual's right to stop work has the full support of Excellence Logging Management, without fear of reprisal, to achieve an injury free workplace.

Only by empowering individuals can the Company progress and preserve the health and safety of all. Everyone is accountable to identify risks and opportunities. We are determined to provide the necessary resources to achieve our goals and will support initiatives for continuous improvement of the OMS.
