

Stop Work Policy

Excellence Logging acknowledges that our employees and other people involved in our activities have a right to a safe and healthy working environment and is firmly committed to maintaining a strong culture of risk awareness.

Our Goals are to ensure optimal prevention of injury to people as well as of damage to our property and the environment; maintain health, safety, and environmental considerations as top priorities; foster responsible behaviour.

Company Management holds the responsibility to ensure the requirements of this policy are communicated, understood, and applied. All employees, contractors, suppliers, consultants, and temporary staff working for Excellence Logging must apply this policy in good faith and reasonably.

Our Requirements are for anyone to STOP work, check and ask when an unsafe work condition, activity or practice is detected which puts employees, other people or the environment in imminent danger; immediately report such events to the responsible manager for further prompt action; resume work only after all needed corrective actions have been reviewed, agreed, approved and the remaining risks, if any, have been judged acceptable.

An individual's right to stop work has the full support of Excellence Logging management, without fear of reprisal, to achieve an injury-free workplace.

Only by empowering individuals can the Company progress and preserve the health and safety of all. Everyone is accountable to identify risks and opportunities. We are determined to provide the necessary resources to achieve our goals and will support initiatives for continuous improvement of the Excellence Logging Management System (OMS).
